

Consonant Blend:

***ft*** (ending)



## Activity: Memory Game *ft*

### Objective:

Students will read and write words with the ending consonant blend *ft*.

### Number of Players: 2

### What You Need:

- 1 set of game cards

### Important Note:

Introduce and practice activity in small, flexible groups prior to independent use in centers.

### Accountability:

Students will practice writing words with the ending consonant blend *ft*. Each player will choose three pairs of cards from their match pile. The first player will call out the three different words to the second player, who will write the words on a sheet of paper. They check their words by looking at the cards. The partners switch roles and repeat the process.



### How to Play:

- Step 1.** Game cards are shuffled and placed word-side down on the table.
- Step 2.** Each player turns over one card. The player whose word comes first alphabetically will be the first player. Those cards are then turned word-side down again before the game begins.
- Step 3.** The first player turns over any two cards and reads the *ft* words written on the cards. If the words are the same, the player makes a match and places the cards in the player's match pile. This process is repeated by the same player until the two words turned up are not a match.
- Step 4.** If the two words turned over and read are not a match, the player turns the cards word-side down again and their turn ends.
- Step 5.** The game ends when all cards have been matched. The player with the most matches wins the game.
